## THE REGISTRATION PROCESS

Prospective students **MUST** be three years of age by August 31 and a resident of the Town of Weymouth. Registration for the Fall begins after February Vacation.

All interested families will pick up a registration packet from the school office. This packet, which can also be printed from the website using the Quick Link to “Student Registration Information”, includes: registration form, developmental questionnaire, proof of residency form, home language survey, health survey, emergency contact sheet, nurse’s pink emergency contact sheet and a Health Services letter regarding immunizations and communicable diseases.

The completed packet will be returned to the school office in person by the parent. At that time the parent must produce the following:

- photo identification
- child’s original birth certificate
- copy of the most recent physical examination and immunization records
- utility bill
- a \$50 non-refundable deposit

Copies will be made by school staff and the originals returned to the parent. At this time, the parent shall indicate the program preference for their child.

Unfortunately, due to the volume of incoming registrants, we are unable to conduct classroom tours. They are very disruptive to the educational process, time intensive, a distraction for staff and pose a security risk for current students. A virtual tour of our program is available by using the link “Virtual School Tour”.

The parent and child will return for an appointment later in the spring so that staff may complete a developmental screening for the child. In August parents will receive an informational letter indicating the program days and time, the teacher’s name, classroom orientation date and tuition information.

**ALL PARENTS MUST ATTEND A MANDATORY PARENT MEETING** on Wednesday evening after Labor Day. Students and their parents will attend a classroom orientation session during the day that same week. School begins the Monday after Labor Day.
