

# COLLEGE ARTICULATION AGREEMENTS

## The Articulation Agreement:

- Provides a career pathway from high school through a post-secondary institution without the duplication of courses.
- Ensures high expectations are established for students.
- Encourages lifelong and applied learning.
- Develops communication between high school teachers and post-secondary faculty who share the same discipline

## Program Pathway

A program pathway is a specified sequence of courses in a career or technical program that begins in high school and continues at the post-secondary institution. The pathway is developed through a collaborative effort with the faculty at both the high school and post-secondary institution. We are a member of the South Shore Collaborative.

## Articulation Agreement

An articulation agreement is a written contract between the high school and post-secondary institution regarding a specific career or technical program. The high school and the post-secondary institution faculty meet to determine similarities in the curriculum and develop a program pathway. Some agreements may grant guaranteed placement in a program while others may grant college credit for courses successfully completed in high school. Each agreement is individually developed to assure a sequence of progressive achievement leading to degrees or certificates in a program.
