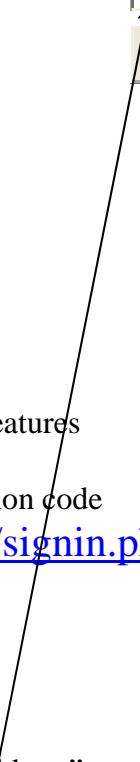
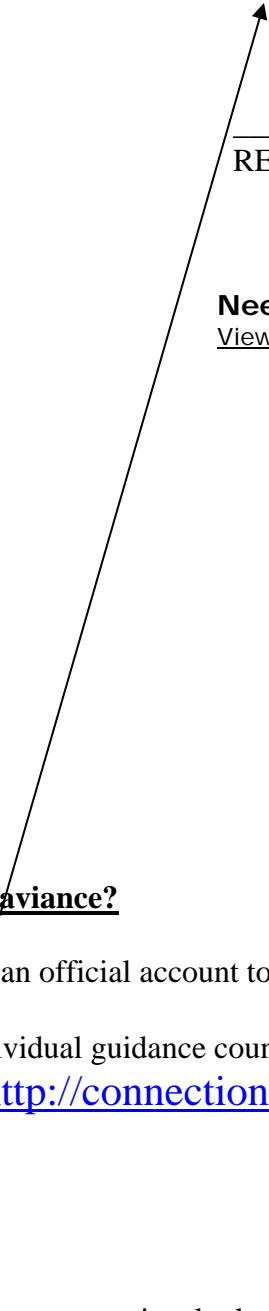
How can I access Naviance?
