Parents of students currently enrolled in the Career and Technical Education program may view their student's competency profile by logging into <a href="www.weymouthschools.skillsport.com">www.weymouthschools.skillsport.com</a>. The User ID and password are the same as those assigned to a student's X2 account.

Progress is updated at the end of Semester 1 and again at the end of the school year. This tracking system allows parents to view their child's competency profile.
