The School shall have no financial responsibility. Sub-contractors may only work on the site, when not occupied by Weymouth High School students.
- ➤ The Sponsor shall purchase all building materials, based on the plans, and have said materials delivered to an agreed upon location, either at the location of the Sponsor or Weymouth High School Carpentry Department.
- ➤ Weymouth High School is not responsible for Electrical, Paint, Landscaping, Plumbing work, or trash removal.

>	The Sponsor shall be responsible for obtaining all permits necessary to comply with federal, state and local statutes, codes, regulations and ordinances.		
>	The Sponsor agrees to indemnify and to hold harmless the School, the Trustees of Weymouth High School, School Committee, and all their agents, employees, and assign, the Superintendent, and Instructors, and all class members, and to indemnify same for any and all claims arising out of this Agreement unless arising from the negligence of one of the aforementioned parties.		
>	The Sponsor shall be available for consultation on the sire at intervals and times of day mutually agreed to by the carpentry instructor and Sponsor, when requested.		
>	The Sponsor reserves the right to reasonably approve all building plans, materials and colors. No construction shall take place prior to the Sponsor's approval.		
>	The School shall be responsible for the necessary transportation of its students.		
>	If, at any time, the conduct of a student is such to impair his/her performance, he/she will be referred to the School for such actions as the School deems necessary.		
>	Students and instructors will be covered by liability insurance A Certificate of Insurance will be provided.		
>	Any student to whom the Sponsor objects shall be removed from the program.
