

Senior Privilege Form

Dear Parent/Guardian:

Your senior may be eligible for Senior Privilege. Senior Privilege allows a student to arrive after first period, if their first period is a study hall (SIP), or leave prior to the last period if their seventh period is a study hall (SIP). Senior Privilege is recalculated each quarter; therefor students must meet all of the requirements each quarter. Teaching obligations such as a teacher/office detention or meeting with a teacher after school take precedent over senior privilege.

In order to be granted Senior Privilege, a student must have:

- A) Passed all necessary MCAS required to graduate.
- B) Good standing with their Capstone Project per their advisor.
- C) Earned an academic average of 80% or better in the previous term.
- D) Few conduct referrals, determined by the Dean.
- E) No outstanding obligations (including community service).

If you believe your student is eligible and you allow them to participate in this program, please sign the form and have your student return it to the <u>maroon office</u>. Once the form is returned, we will determine if you student is eligible for Senior Privilege.

If your student is not currently eligible, they can request that their application be reviewed at the beginning of each term to see if they meet the requirements.
