



TRANSPORTATION

Update on Ridership for PreK-12

- Buses are limited to transport 21-24 students (social distancing)
- Vans are limited to transport 3-4 students (social distancing)
- Shortage of drivers, monitors & outside vendors
- Looking to potentially add a van, but will need a driver
- Reviewing the possibility to share vehicles from other town departments



PROPOSED PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT (PD) CHANGES:

- 1. Replace Nov. 10th PD with a school day for students
- 2. November 3rd PD day becomes choice day for staff
- 3. Move Staff PD day Tuesday Dec 8th to Monday Dec 7th to avoid in-person school day
- 4. Cancel half-day PD on Mondays for the year
- 5. Waiting to hear from WEA about choice day change
