~ Price Per Sport = \$200 excluding Football (\$250), Hockey (\$400), and Unified Sports (\$50)
- Any student-athlete who receives either a Free or a Reduced Lunch, is eligible to pay $1 / 2$ the User Fee price.
~ \# of Student-Athletes on Free \& Reduced Lunch = 124
