Overview

Weymouth Redistricting Options Considered

- 2 Buildings(6-8); 8 Primaries K-5 or K Center & 7 Primaries
- 2 Buildings(5-8), Seach becomes K Center, 7 Primaries
- 1 Building(6-8), Adams is 9th Primary School
- Full Day K available to all

Four Redistricting Scenarios

- Scenario 1:
 - two buildings with Grades 6-8
- Scenario 2:
 - two buildings with Grades 5-8, K Center (Seach), and 1-4 Grades in seven schools
- Scenario 3:
 - New Chapman grades 6-8; K-5 in nine buildings (Adams 9th primary)
- Scenario 4:
 - Full Day K available to all

Scenario 1:

Two 6-8 Middle Schools

#1A – K-5 Primary Schools

#1B – Kindergarten Center; 1st-5th in Primary Schools

Neither option will work.

Scenario 1A

Key Elements:

1. All K-4 in current school
2. Move all 5th grade students to the previous primary school
3. Two middle schools with grades 6-8 grades (Adam and Chapman)

Over 1 classroom

Short 19 classrooms overall



Scenario 1B


Key Elements:

1. Move all K students to Seach
2. Move all Seach students in Grades 1-4 to **geographically closest** school
3. All other Grade 1-4 students stay in current school
4. Move 5th grade students to **geographically closest** school
5. Two middle schools with Grades 6-8 (Adam and Chapman)

Short 22 classrooms

Over 9 classrooms

Short 13 classrooms overall



Scenario 2

- Kindergarten Center at Seach
- Grades 1-4 in Primary Schools
- Two Grade 5-8 Middle Schools

This option will work.

Scenario 2


Key Elements:

1. Move all K students to Seach
2. Move Seach Grade 1-4 students to **geographically closest** school
3. All other Grade 1-4 students stay in current school
4. Two middle schools with 5-8 grades (Adam and Chapman)

Short 8 Classrooms

Over 18 Classrooms

10 extra classrooms overall



Scenario 3

- New Chapman Grades 6-8
- Adams becomes ninth primary school (K-5)
- Note: This is Option D in MSBA Education Plan

This option will work.

Scenario 4

- Full Day K for all
- Status quo for all other grades

This option will work.




Scenario 4

Key Elements:

1. Full Day K for all
2. Showing status quo – no redistricting

Full day K now before MSBA project.

**Short 0 Classrooms
Over 15 classrooms
Net 15 classrooms**



Summary:

Weymouth Redistricting Scenarios

Scenario 1 - **Will Not Work**

2 Buildings(6-8); 8 Primaries K-5 or K Center & 7 Primaries

Scenario 2 - **Could Work**

2 Buildings(5-8), Seach becomes K Center, 7 Primaries

Scenario 3 - **Could Work**

1 Building(6-8), Adams is 9th Primary School

Scenario 4 - **Could Work**

Full Day K available to all



Scenarios That Could Work

Kindergarten Center (Seach)	Full or Half Day K in each of the Primaries	Full Day Kindergarten for all
Seven Primary Schools (Grades 1-4)	Nine Primary Schools (Grades K-5)	Eight Primary Schools (Grades K-4)
Two Middle Schools (Grades 5-8)	One Middle School (Grades 6-8)	Two Middle Schools (Grades 5-6 and Grades 7- 8)
