# LEAVE COVERAGE AND ADDITIONAL STAFF

- **Long Term Substitutes for Unit A**
  - Long Term Subs to cover approx ~77 leaves (WPS staff **AND** sub being paid)
- **Building Substitutes**~10 additional to decrease daily substitute usage
- **Childcare**~Currently offering school-age childcare for staff (this is NOT WHS childcare program)
- **Bus Monitors**
  - Temporary during hybrid; DESE recommended
  - 13 out of 15 positions not filled
- **Remote Learning Support Staff**
  - Grant funded temporary positions through end of December
