Assistant Superintendent Mary Ann Bryan came to the table to provide an update on the Next Generation Accountability System. She reviewed the new pieces:

No Composite Performance Index (CPI) or PPI (Progress and Performance Index) → Using Average Scale Score Instead

- 2018 (Grades 3-8)
- 2019 (All Grades)

Student Growth Percentile (SGP)

• Mean, not median, in 2018 and beyond

MCAS 2.0 is vertically aligned

- 500 means the same regardless of content or grade level
- Comparison can be made across content areas (ELA vs Math) and grade levels

MCAS-Alt will have scaled scores

Replacing *High Needs* sub-group with *Lowest Quartile* for School Accountability decisions

Mrs. Bryan then reviewed Accountability indicators for Primary and Middle Schools as well as the High School. She reviewed the Normative Piece: School Percentiles, Categorized School Districts.
