The Committee reviewed school committee calendar dates for 2016- 2017 with Dr. Whipple and asked to inform her of any conflicts or changes.

Dr. Curtis-Whipple led a discussion on Compass Points- Understanding preferences in group work. Discussion between members and the Superintendent of what leadership type and skills each had and how the differences can compliment each other when working in a group.
