Creating a Hanging Indentation for a Citation with Google Docs

Citations on a Works Cited list or Bibliography must be formatted using Hanging Indentations. A Hanging Indentation is when the first line of the citation is left justified and every following line is indented.

Example:

Author. "Title of source." Title of Website. Publisher, Publication Date,

website url, Date of Access.

To create a Hanging Indentation for a citation, perform the following steps:

- 1. Highlight the Citation
- 2. Go to Format, then Align and Indent, then Indentation Options
- 3. Under Special Indent choose Hanging
- 4. Apply
