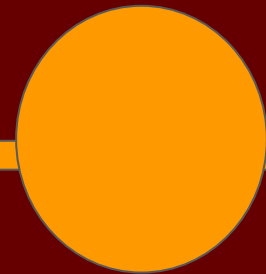
Why Create A Black Student Union?

- Get rid of stigma on race



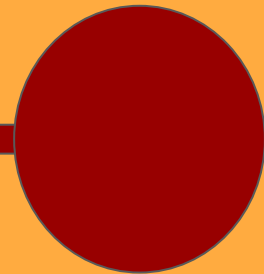
Mission Statement

The Weymouth High Black Student Union intends to build a positive mosaic focused on diversity, equity and inclusion.



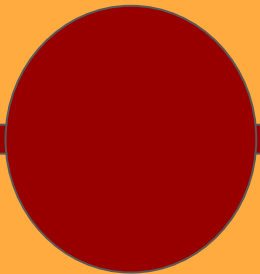

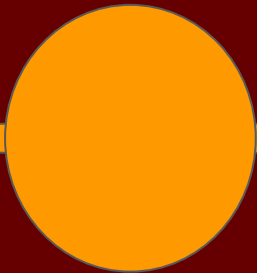
What do we plan on doing?
